Floor Care Guide

General

Floormaster believe that following simple aftercare will ensure that your newly restored wood floor will stay in good condition and gain longevity from our service

- Regularly clean your floor dust and dirt from foot traffic can be abrasive and similar to a high powered sander at work
- A doormat at entrances will help to prevent debris build up
- Avoid replacing rugs on your floor for 1 week after treatment
- When vacuuming use a soft bristle head or a simple dust broom
- When mopping your floor use Treatex
 Floor Care or a PH neutral cleaner. A
 Micro dust mop will provide the most
 effective cleaning
- Avoid using detergents or harsh chemicals as these will damage your floor and dull the finish ie. Fairy liquid, cream cleaners, all purpose cleaners



- Water is your wood floors #1 enemy, it can soak into the wood and cause floorboards to warp and stain, so mop up any spills with a dry cloth as soon as they occur
- Never use a steam cleaner on your wood floor
- Fit all your furniture with protective pads to prevent scratches and scrapes

Recoat only in future no need to resand

- Resanding removes approx. 2mm of wood from your floor, recoating prolongs the length of time between full sanding. It is essential to recoat before to much damage has been done
- Spot repairs are possible on floors treated with Treatex it is not necessary to re sand the whole area
- Drying time approximately 6 hours in ideal conditions. Good ventilation speeds up drying time
- Treatex has a curing time 3 to 4 days
